
CLINIC NEWS

We've had a busy few months here at Spring Paddocks, with a wide mix of routine appointments, emergencies, in-depth lameness examinations and poor performance investigations. Our **gastroscopy** service remains as popular as ever, with large numbers of horses and ponies having their stomachs checked and those with significant gastric ulceration have responded excellently to treatment.

Our visiting **specialist surgeons** have also been assessing and treating cases including dentistry referrals and expert orthopaedic surgery.

The Spring Paddocks Veterinary team remains the same, with John, Gemma, Katrina and Stef providing all your equine veterinary care. Remember that we provide our own **out of hour's** service, so in an emergency you will always see a familiar face.

Our **in house Laboratory** has been put to good use over the last few months with some interesting medicine cases coming into the clinic.



CURRENT NEWS



We are now in the process of administering this year's batch of **Insol** (sweet itch) vaccine. Having had such a brilliant response to the vaccine last year we have had many repeat customers this year. If you have a horse that suffers with Sweet itch or would like to know more about this service for next year then please contact the clinic.

There has been a lot of media interest around the recent outbreak of **Equine Influenza** (flu). There have been several cases reported in England, as close as Leicestershire, and therefore we are advising clients to be extra aware of any of the following clinical signs:



Lethargy, nasal discharge, dry coughs, inappetance, high temperature (>38.5°C), conjunctivitis, lower leg filling and enlarged glands are all reasons to call a vet. Early diagnosis, isolation and supportive treatment are vital to prevent spread of this very contagious disease. We recommend checking that all your horses' vaccinations are up to date as this hugely reduces the chances of your horse contracting the disease. Current recommendations, in light of the recent outbreak, are that every horse that has not been vaccinated within the last 6 months should have a booster flu vaccine as soon as possible. Please call the clinic if you are concerned about whether your horse is up to date with their vaccinations.
